2 Conditions and Registration to Race

2.3 Added wording applicable to visiting vessels:

Entry by email or hard copy must be received at the CYC office **by 3pm. Friday 7th June 2019**.

Late, 'on the line entries', can be made by calling 'Bateman's Tower', CH 37/M1/N1 **20 minutes** before the first start sequence. In the interests of safety you will be required to state:

1. Your name as the person in charge.
2. Your sail number and hull colour
3. The name and type/class of your vessel.
4. The number of persons on board.

Note: Skippers/Persons in Charge making race entry via VHF must:

5. Confirm that you have read the CYC sailing instructions and amendments for this event.
6. Confirm that your vessel has the required insurance cover.
7. Confirm that you accept the terms stated on the entry form.

NOTE: On completion of the courses below the finish is at the CYC Club Line leaving: Creek Mouth P, Minters Point buoy in the creek S, finishing through the CYC Club Line denoted by a triangular transit on the seawall and the CYC clubhouse flagpole.

Start line at Batemans Tower - between the limit mark and Batemans Tower

All courses are 2 rounds unless code flag 'S' is shown on the first round

A: 15.S PC.S IF.S BAT.S Line	F: PC.P 12.P Line
B: PC.S ST.S BAT.P 12.S 15.S Line	H: IF.P PC.P 15.P Line
C: HILL.P BB:P BAT.P Line	J: CM.S IF.S 12.S 15.S MW.P BAT.S Line
D: ST.P PC.P 12.S 17.S Line	K: CM.S IF.S BAT.P 15.P 12.P Line
E: PC.S ST.S BAT.P 12.P Line	

MW = Mersea Wreck **BAT** = Bateman's **CM** = Creekmouth
ST = Stone **PC** = Point Clear **IF** = Inner Fishery
BB = Big Buoy **Hill** = Hills **Minter's Point** is the green stbd hand mark at the end of Cindery Island in the creek.
