# NOTICE OF RACE (BODs & Open Classics) sh.1 of 2 100th Anniversary Regatta Race, Sat. 8th June 2019

There **is a voluntary entry fee of £5 per boat**. Please pay over Colne YC's bar or direct via the Ausome website. This contains details of 22 year old Lottie Harland's plans to campaign, 'Lyra of London', a Swan 431 from Burnham and a regular EAORA racer, in the 2019 Fastnet Race with an all autistic crew. We wish Lottie, Lyra & her crew every success!

### 1. RULES.

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 1.3 Part 5, Section B of The Racing Rules of Sailing, as well as rules 44.1 and 63.1 will be changed in the Sailing Instructions to permit Protest Arbitration.
- 1.4 Competitors will be required to wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times whilst afloat – except for a short period whilst changing clothing. Flag 'Y' will not be displayed; this changes RRS rules 40.1 and Race Signals 'Y'.
- 1.5 All boats shall carry a working VHF radio ready for use.

### 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20 and the Class Rules. (N.B Personal Advertising is prohibited).

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The CYC 100th Anniversary Regatta Race is open to BODs and open classics owned or chartered to any CYC member, or visiting yachtsman who are members of an RYA affiliated Yacht or Sailing club.
- 3.2 Visiting competitors are requested to complete a CYC '**100th Anniversary Regatta Race Entry Form**', which should then be lodged with CYC's office no later than Friday 7th June 2019, 3pm.

Race entry can be made from the water 20 minutes prior to the published start using VHF CH 37/M1/N1, callsign, 'Bateman's Tower', as laid out in document, '**Amendments, Additions and Deletions to CYC Sailing Instructions 2019 for the Colne Yacht Club 100th Anniversary Regatta Race, Sat. 8th June 2019**', listing your vessels details as outlined in *para. 2.4*. Please ensure you place your vessel so that can be visually identified from the Bateman's Tower race box whilst you radio in.

### 4. CLASSIFICATION AND CREW

- 4.1 There are no ISAF Sailor Classification Code requirements.

### 5. FEES

- 5.1 A voluntary £5 per boat entry fee will apply, all entry monies will be given to the Ausome Charity to help an autistic crew fund their Fastnet 2019 project. Go to [www.ausome.org.uk/sailing](http://www.ausome.org.uk/sailing) for further details.

### 6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The Schedule shall be as published on the CYC calendar and on the BOD Class Website

### 7. MEASUREMENT and EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1 The Organisers may weigh measure or inspect any boat and or her equipment and sails before, during or after the races to ensure conformity with the Class Rules. 7.2 Sails shall be measured and stamped by an approved measurer before racing.
